Abstract

Web pages have become a common tool for communication and advertising the service and product available in a company especially with the increasing popularity of the Internet facility in Malaysia.

In this project I created web site for Syarikat First Agency and Syarikat First Agency Sdn. Bhd. a book vendor and publisher for two different purpose. The first is the web page should promote the vendor as a representative of U.S and U.K. publishers, dealer and distributor for the foreign and local customers. This web will also deal in marketing and distribution of books for the SouthEast and FarEast region, making Malaysia as the their regional center.

The second purpose of the web page is also have its own identity which will deal mainly with local customers and the government agency. It have option where the local customer or government agency will able to view listing of its customers for convincing bidding of government or local agency tenders.

Both of the company will have same information and e-mail contacts but one deal in publishing and the other as book vendor and distributor

There will be inter link between the two web, where a user will able to browse from one web to another web and also the down line of the each web.

Introduction

Preamble

The web pages are programmed using HTML and JAVA programming language and Visual Basic to interface with database created in Microsoft Access. The first web contented name of the companies with the back ground under the control of a animation program. On top of the companies names frame there is a banner that will exist though out all the other sub-web pages.

The banner basically sub divided all the sub web pages into four major categories. The first option provided is the home of the web page it self. The second option leads to the companies history, companies profile, directors and also the contact information for their customers or business partners. The following sub web page leads to the companies activities. At this section the activities are sub divided further into two categories. One for the international level and the other for the local level specially for the government contract bidding which will abusively need to know the standing of the company in the local business environment. These two pages are further sub divided into many other pages to give more details information related to their publishing and distribution activities. Both of the main page of the activities also do allow the user to access the company's database to look into the availability of the books or magazines.

The last option of the banner list latest news or product that is available at the company. It also display the location map of the company for those who wants to visit the company for any business.

Objective

The main objective of the web page is to promote the sales of the organization. Other then sales the secondary objective is to improve communication between the organization and the existing clients also to improve the overall image of the organization. Nowadays in Malaysia, every organization is trying to achieve some standard of I.T. involvement in their daily operation, by having their own web, both the government and non-government agency will able to access the availability of products (books) without even calling the company and requesting information.

Common inquiry by customer by phone can be reduced, and this reduces workload of answering general inquiry. Faxing information to and from company also can be reduced , when the customer start using e-mail and ordering from the web to make orders. Generally many organization spend quit a some on the advertisement, the web are 24 hours, 365 days advertisement and accessible to the whole world. Direct access by customers and business partners to the company's database will save much more time and money by both the customer and the company and allowing a proper flow of information.

Scope

Project scope states the boundaries of the system to be analyzed, designed and implemented. It state what aspect of the organization will be address by the project and what will the project attempt to do. Defining the scope of the project is very important because problems tend to expend if no firm boundaries are established. Limitation are also necessary to stay within the eventual budget and schedule.

The scope of the system are define in line with the objective set earlier as follow:

- The web page must create awareness, this is done by the activities sub pages. This pages organise the activities of the companies in systematic manner so that the user will understand the nurture of companies the business.
- Secondly the to act as the companies marketing tool. This again is achieved by having sufficient information on the local and foreign business partners (this inclusive of publishers and distributors), information on the type of the companies customers, by groping them in groups.
- Thirdly the web page has to play apart as communication tool. To achieve this the web has option in making online inquiries using the form provided in the web. There is also an option in the web where the user can access to the e-mail, telephone no, fax no and location map if there are to visit the company.
- Lastly the web page also provide direct access to the database of the company, this involve in developing the database system for the company and programs that interface with the database and html files. All most all of the web pages display the last updated date to let the user know where the information receive by them is up to date.

Significance

The significance of this project is it will improve the awareness and the existent of Syarikat First Agency and Syarikat First Agency Sdn.Bhd's business group. Other major contributions of the project is that the web page would play very important role in marketing and communication in the local and also the foreign business environment.

In terms of cost-benefit the web will cost saving approach in marketing program and the impact will improve as the number of Internet user increasing every day.

Cost benefit analysis:

Definitions

Book vendor and publisher is referring to Syarikat First Agency and Syarikat First Agency Sdn. Bhd. which deals in books and magazines. As a publisher it need to deal with the publishing process, writers and printing of books. As a vendor it will be representative of various publisher in sales and books distributor.

The other issue that a reader need to know is the use of term such as "Syarikat First Agency" and "Syarikat First Agency Sdn. Bhd.". These refer to two different companies which belong to the same business group. The first deals at the international level and the second want deals more for the local customers and government agencies.

Limitation

The company is not fully in automation environment, this could lead to few limitation of the web page system. The following are some of the limitation that the user or the company might face:-

- The web being design Syarikat First Agency and Syarikat First Agency Sdn. Bhd. does not involve the electronic-ordering of books using credit cards because the company does not have the facilities and on top of that it is beyond the scope set at the earlier during the proposal of the project.
- The company need to update the book list in their database system and the fourth option of the web regarding latest news from the company.
- Inquiries made via the web page will not be down loaded into inquiries database automatically but have to be viewed as an individual e-mail.
- Some of the programming is done using Visual Basic, this will only be assessable via internet explorer

Review of Literature

Purpose

The purpose of reviewing the existing Web page for book vendors was to find out the best suited web for foreign and also local user. To height light and analyze the major needs or the tease of foreign and the local customers. My findings were, the best business Web sites (in terms of being attractive and generating customer and prospect traffic) are designed according to the following guidelines:

- * Cohesion
- Design & Layout
- * Consideration of the download time.

This report first developed these issues and then presents an analysis of verity's Web site followed by some suggestions.

Following are the sources of my findings:

Approach

The approach use in reviewing the web was by :-

- 1. Internet
- Checking on existing web site.
- b. Looking on what is being place on the web.
- Colour and the layout use on the web pages.(the type of human interface used)
- d. The flow of the web pages.

The other issue looked in to during collecting of information on the web page was looking into the organisation relevance. This is to choose best fit design for Syrikat Frist Agency web page in improving its efficiency and effectiveness in the define scope of the project.

Findings

My finding on the collection of data above enable me to come out with basic guidelines on the design and layout of the web. The following are the findings:-

- Layout use has some impact on the visitors to the web.
- The web design should take into consideration of the facilities the user might be having. (The minimum configuration of communication tool and type of explorer)
- The design should be simple and easy to navigate the web page. This means the user must able to navigate from one sub page to any other sub page, and not necessary navigating through the hierarchy sub pages.

Analysis

Analysing the finding above I discover the following:-

1. Aesthetics aspects of Web design

Oversized graphics

Some graphics affect the size of the windows, i.e. over 640 pixels width. This causes a scrollbar to appear at the bottom of the standard Netscape windows for PC's. In the case of a big graphic versus multiple tiny images. Smaller images are batter in reducing the down loading time. In the case of bigger images on the Home Page, it could be divided in smaller ones, in order to minimize the download time.

Reuse of same images

In the same way, the reuse of same images on different pages of the Web site reduces the download time (using the cache function of Netscape browser). Also this cache function enables the reuse of multiple images as overlays or a montage for a "new" image.

Color of graphics

Some graphics differ from one monitor to another. The first question to ask is: "Were they created using the 256 non-dithering palette (or better yet the Netscape 216 palette)?" The type of color chosen in the web is base on the 256 non-dithering palette to optimize the coloring option on monitors, specially in Syarikat First Agency and Syarikat First Agency Sdn. Bhd. web where an animation of color changes happen on the home page.

2. Navigation

Difficulty of finding some sections

If some sections are hard to find and are key to the site, they should be included in the toolbar on each page.

Existence of some broken links

A professional Web site should avoid any broken link or reference to non-existent information/data.

The position of the link to the text page

If the Home Page is highly graphic oriented, then the link to the text page should appear at the top of the Home Page and not at the bottom, because a user with a low connection won't wait and will simply leave the site before seeing this link.

Graphics versus Image maps

Image maps are graphics that serves also as navigation tool (by pointing on an area and clicking with his mouse a user has access to the specified document).

The web created for the companies have over come the possible problem mention above by using a banner of animation graphics image on top of every page and sub pages to ovoid broken link problem and missing of the links in the page. The user will never get in to trouble of getting to the home of the page or any other four option of sub pages or returning from the sub pages to the home page.

3. Design & Layout

Better classification of information

The first task is to find a better classification of information. Better results are achieved through feedback and inputs collected through emails, phone calls, meetings and presentations. Design issues:

Electronic versus Print Publishing

Electronic Publishing is different from Print Publishing. The electronic publishing is more effective because of the graphics and animation. The web can be modify in future to suite the changes in the company or policy.

Some redundancy problems

A Web designer needs to pay particularly attention to this problem in case of stratification of the Web site. Indeed some elements might not be consistent and redundant. This has been over come in this web by having common page for request or links from two or more different pages.

4. Corporate identity

Lack of consistency in some sections

Because of its evolution and big size, a Web site is not always consistent. There might be stratifications of "look and feel". Hyperlinks allow users to virtually "jump" from one site to another; therefore, it is critical to ensure recognition and identity. The corporate identity of the Syarikat First Agency and Syarikat First Agency Sdn. Bhd. is maintained by using common background for the web pages.

Unity Problems

Typography and layout may vary throughout the Web site and then don't maintain the corporate image, specifically in the case of absence of logo. It is critical that the user knows that he/she is still visiting the corporate Web site. The use of common layout and background had help to over come this problem in the web pages.

The conclusions for the analysis above are:

- Ensure that all web pages are consistent in balance, tone and feel. The two different company are in the same group. Then it may be good idea to establish formal web style guidelines to facilitate consistency.
- Be user friendly. The webs site will be design in such a way that users can easily locate the information they need. All pages directly linked to the home page within the site should the users with a link back to the home page.
- Keep graphics relatively small. As a rule of thumb, graphics should be no larger than 6.5"(468 pixels) wide and 3"(216 pixels) wide. This will allow those users with 13"

monitors to view the image without scrolling. It may be a good idea to first provide a small version (stamp or footprint) of the graphic that act a link to the larger graphic. It is also good to use fewer colour for the images.

- Do not use too many graphics to allow those who use less sophisticated browsers or have slow connections, to benefit from the site.
- ** Keep the page simple and clutter-free. Don't try to stack too much information in one screen.
- Always provide a footer that includes the webmasters name and e-mail address, as well as the date the page was last up dated.

Methodology

Project Description

Web pages project for the Syarikat First agency and Syarikat First agency Sdn. Bhd. were designed by taking into consideration of:-

- Audience of the Web
- Navigation
- Electronic publishing process
- Next priorities.

1. Knowing the audience of the Web site

These cross-analysis will also be useful for the Marketing Department.

This will consists not in displaying hits, but by comparing traffic and Web design & communication issues, analyzing why we loose or gain general traffic, why some pages are more visited than others This will help to design a successful Web site, and keep it successful.

External and internal opinion from research reports from the internet and the marketing, sales and technical staff of Syarikat First Agency have been taken in to account as an asset for creating value-added information on the web.

Indeed, the Internet culture is based on exchange, and furthermore a Web site is not only a marketing and information tool, but a communication tool based on interactivity or two-way communication.

2. Better navigation

> Image map and/or toolbar

An image map on the Home Page that includes a navigation menu, or separate the toolbar (image map) from the rest of the graphic have been created. This is to indicate the current section on the toolbar, to ensure that the user knows what section he is currently viewing in his browser, as well as a better use of the space. Because standards windows are 480 pixels height, the title of the page and the information about links in the form of banner appear on top of the every page.

3. Electronic Publishing Process

Define the Web communication approach of Verity

This issue is not based on technical aspects nor on aesthetic considerations, but rather on the company's perception of its customers' reactions and on its Web strategy. Also the Web communication approach is strongly intricate with the choice of education of the user.

A) Giving users a good image through the Web site is critical for a corporation:

This medium and its specific publishing process provide great capabilities in terms of interactivity or two-way communication, in order to improve the customer relationship. Improve interactivity of the Web site. Encourage current customers to visit the Web site. For example, send automatic email with announcements on updates, new information and allow the user to check on books available in the stock of the companies.

B) Educating the user

The Web communication approach will define the way of educating the users. Two options are available with this new medium:

- > Giving the information easily in detriment of the organization of the Web site.
- A strongly structured site with a Home Page that provides entries to the different sections.

C). Redundant Information

This choice of communication introduces redundancy by providing multiple access to the same information. The asset of this is, users don't have to look for this information within the Web site but then the drawback of this idea is the organization of the Web site is less clearly divided into separate entries or sections. In optimization of the structural and reducing the redundancy an agreement was achieve between the Syarikat First Agency and Syarikat First agency Snd. Bhd. on how many sub pages or hierarchy is to be created at each sub pages.

D). A strongly structured site

The Home Page is simply a port of entry and presents links (graphic and text links) to the different sections. It is very important to put cross-site links for the sub-levels of a such site. In the web page for the Syarikat First Agency and Syarikat First Agency Snd. Bhd. the use of banner on top of the every page made the information strongly structured, and redundancy is limited. Therefore, the access to the information made easy and as direct as possible, through a better structure of the Web site. This allow the critical information to be accessible through the shorter way.

The decision making process was define and the key decision makers within marketing, sales, and technical support departments were identified. The requirements and milestones for the graphic and HTML designers were define this follow by experimentation of ideas on a mirror site, then there were implemented on the Web site after approval. Quality for the publishing process was achieve through spelling tools and

software that searches for broken links (such as Sitemill from Adobe). Ensure good layout on the screen (specific electronic requirements) as well as for a printed version (print publishing requirements). Type of information will affect the importance of the publishing requirements, i.e. in case of conflict between the two kinds of requirements, the priorities was defined (press releases for example requires print publishing guidelines, as well as electronic ones; for section pages, the relevant topic is electronic publishing).

4. Next priorities

- First priority: Home Page Design
- Indeed the Home Page Design is critical because it gives the first perception of the Web site. The Home Page should be responsive, attractive, well organized and clearly structured, in order to sustain willingness to visit the site and learn more about the company and its products. The non-dithering color palette of limited size in 10K of the graphics (whenever possible tiny images versus a big image) Use of Width on the screen should be fixed to 640 by defining the maximum width of graphic to 615 pixels.
- Second priority was to ensure the site with wide consistency by surfing the company's Web site which has common background layout. This will make the user aware that he/she is still viewing the same site? It was critical to solve this problem because it affects the corporate image and identity. Logos, banner, toolbars HTML, JAVA animation topography, text colors (links and hyperlinks, titles), style sheets (grid templates), tables was used to improved the appearances.

> Third Priority: Redefine the architecture of the Web site

Sections

Menus

Cross-links

Flow of information

> Fourth priority: Create Web site's unity

A specific typography and layout will also maintain the corporate image, even in the case of absence of logo. By creating a specific "look and feel", the user will know that he is still visiting the same Web site.

Approach

The Approach used in developing the web page is waterfall approach. The traditional system development paradigm focuses on the system function, its primary strategy is functional decomposition in which high-level functions are successively decomposed into detail functions. Thus, system development under this paradigm are process-driven. In developing the web pages there will be four major stages or activities. Refer to the diagram below:




Figure 1 The waterfall concept

Justification

The reason for using the waterfall method in designing the web pages were :

- The web pages are actually menu driven from one page to the other, so it is easier to create the main page then to the sub-pages. Waterfall method is suitable for this purpose.
- Every sub-page design should be independent from the other sub pages in-term of hyperlink. This again is very well supported by the waterfall approach.
- Waterfall method support the modular designing concept and this modular concept was used during designing each web page or sub-pages.






Block diagram of the home page

Testing

DEFINING WEBSITE QUALITY & RELIABILITY

Like any complex piece of software there is no single, all inclusive quality measure that fully characterizes a Web page. There are many dimensions of quality; each measure will pertain to a particular Web site in varying degrees. Here are some common measures that I have taken during the architecture stage to improve the quality and reliability of the web site.

Timeliness:-

Web sites change often and rapidly, highlight the parts and date last the page was updated.

Structural Quality:

Insure that all of the parts of the Web site hold together are all links inside and outside the Web site. Check on all of the images whether working as needed.

Content:

Check that the content of critical pages match what is supposed to be there and do the critical pages maintain quality content from version to version

Accuracy and Consistency:

Check that the pages downloaded at different day and system maintain the accuracy and consistency

Response Time and Latency:

Check on whether the Web site server respond to a browser request within certain performance parameters. In an E-commerce context, it is the end-to-end response time

after a SUBMIT This are important there parts of a site because if the system is so slow the user might discontinues working.

Performance:

This is to check that the Browser->Web->WebSite->Web->Browser connection quick enough

WEBSITE TEST AUTOMATION REQUIREMENTS

Assuring Web site quality requires conducting sets of tests, automatically and repeatable, that demonstrate required properties and behaviors. Here are some required elements of tools that aim to do this.

Test Sessions. Typical elements of tests involve these characteristics:

Browser Independent. Tests should be realistic, but not be dependent on a particular browser, whose biases and characteristics might mask a Web Site's problems.

No Buffering, Caching. Local caching and buffering is often a way to improve apparent performance should be disabled so that timed experiments are a true measure of the Browser-Web-Web site-Web-Browser response time.

Fonts and Preferences. Most browsers support a wide range of fonts and presentation preferences, and these should not affect how quality on a Web Site is assessed or assured.

Object Mode. Edit fields, push buttons, radio buttons, check boxes, etc. All should be treatable in object mode, i.e. independent of the fonts and preferences.

Object mode operation is essential to protect an investment in test suites and to assure that test suites continue operating when Web site pages experience change. In other words, when buttons and form entries change location on the screen as they often do the tests should still work.

However, when a button or other object is deleted, that error should be sensed! Adding objects to a page clearly implies re-making the test.

Tables and Forms. Even when the layout of a table or form varies in the browser's view, tests of it should continue independent of these factors.

Frames. Windows with multiple frames ought to be processed simply, i.e. as if they were multiple single-page frames.

Test Context. Tests need to operate from the browser level for two reasons: (1) this is where users see a Web site, so tests based in browser operation are the most realistic; and (2) tests based in browsers can be run locally or across the Web equally well. Local execution is fine for quality control, but not for performance measurement work, where response time including Web-variable delays reflective of real-world usage is essential.

WEBSITE DYNAMIC VALIDATION

Confirming validity of what is tested is the key to assuring Web site quality -- the most difficult challenge of all. Here are four key areas where test automation had a significant impact.

Operational Testing. Individual test steps was involve a variety of checks on individual pages in the Web site:

Page Consistency. Was to the check entire page identical with a prior version and look in to the key parts of the text whether they are the same or different?

Table and Form Consistency. Make sure all of the parts of a table or form present, correctly laid out selected texts are in the "right place".

Page Relationships. Test on all of the links on a page the same as they were before check for any missing links and broken links

Performance Consistency, Response Times. The response time for a user action the same as it was or within a range

Implementation
