Despite Megalosaurus being the first named dinosaur, very little is still known about it. No complete skeletons have ever been found and scientists have tried to work out its life style from that of other meat eaters. We know that it lived about 170 million years ago, at a time when the Earth's weather was mild. The world's plants were large and plentiful, as in a rainforest today. There were forest trees such as conifers, cycads and ginkgoes, and ferns and horsetails grew on the ground. This scene would have been home to Megalosaurus, a predatory dinosaur that stalked through the vegetation in search of prey, such as Iguanodon. DISCOVERY

Megalosaurus was not the biggest meat eater that walked on Earth, yet its name "great lizard" marks it out as being, in some way, special. In the story of dinosaur discoveries, this was the animal whose prehistoric remains, found in the south of England, were first thought to belong to a giant reptile. As early as 1676, a bone from Megalosaurus had caused scientists in England to wonder what kind of animals had once lived. One scientist said that the bone belonged to a giant elephant, brought to England by the Romans.


Another believed it was from the skeleton of a giant human! No one came up with a better idea until 1822, when James Parkinson examined a collection of fossil bones and teeth found at a slate quarry near Oxford. He correctly identified them as coming from a giant reptile, a lizard, which he named Megalosaurus. This was the first time a dinosaur had been described and named - though the world would have to wait another 20 years before the word "dinosaur" was invented.

DINOSAUR WASTE BASKET

We know that Megalosaurus was s meat-eater that lived in what is now Europe, Bi things have not always been this way. In the early years of dinosaur studies, scientists thought that all bones from large meat-eaters came from the same species of dinosaur. They were all labelled as Megalosaurus bones. Megalosaurus became a "waste basket" name into which lots of different species were placed by mistake. These old mistakes are now being corrected and the bones are being correctly identified with the right dinoscurs.






