Intellectual stimulation	A value associated with work that provides the opportunity for independent thinking and for learning how and why things work.
Achievement	A value associated with work that gives one a feeling of accomplishment in doing a job well.
Independence	A value associated with work that permits one to work in his own way, as fast or as slowly as he wishes
Prestige	A value associated with work that gives one standing in the eyes of others and evokes respect.
Management	A value associated with work that permits one to plan and lay out work for other to do.
Economic returns	A value associated with work that pays well and enables one to have things he wants.
Security	A value associated with work that provides one with the certainty of having a job even in hard times.
Surroundings	A value associated with work that is carried out under pleasant conditions.
Supervisory relations	A value associated with work that is carried out under a supervisor who is fair and with whom one can get along
Associates	A value associated with work that brings one in contact with fellow workers whom he likes
