



A tour of the town is not complete without a visit here which houses a rich collection of historical items. Tourists as well as locals can also find out about the old history of Pahang here.	A trip to this lush and exotic tropical island is a must for all nature lovers. Surrounded by dense jungle, swaying palm trees, white sandy beaches, sapphire blue sky and a colourful coral garden, this island is renowned as one of Malaysia's marine paradise.
With a site of 38 km long and 19 km at its greatest width, this island is the largest of a group 64 volcanic islands. It is also a magnificent island in the sun, with crystal-clear water for swimming.
