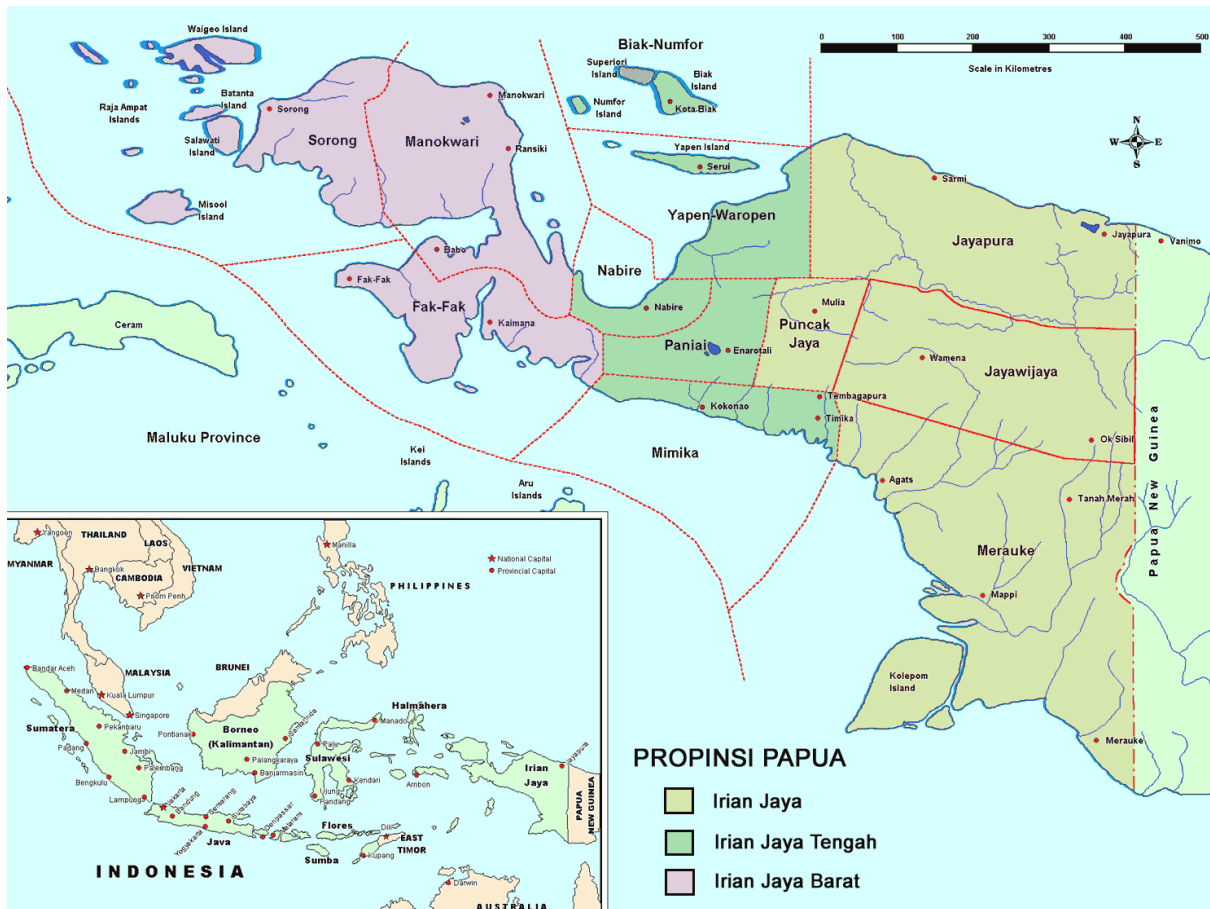


Peta 1: Papua Barat

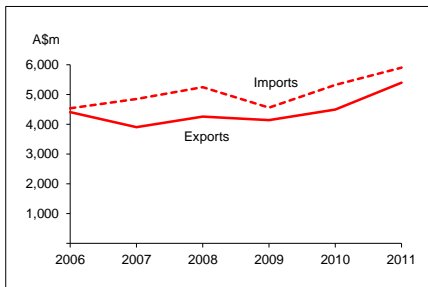

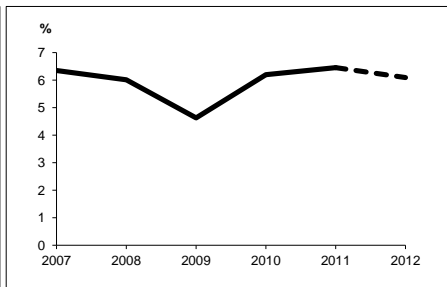

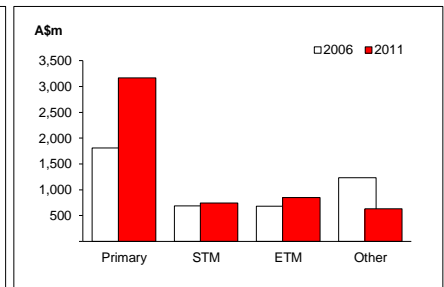
Australia's merchandise trade with Indonesia
