The importance of foreign trade to the Helayan export dominated economy cannot be understimated. Realising this fundamental phonomenom, the study proposes to examine the past trends in visible trade between the Federation of Malaya and Japan for the ten year period 1954-1963, and the future of the existing trade between the two countries with the establishment of helaysia. Only exports and imports are being studied because data on the invisible trade is not readily evailable. Though the period under study covers a decade, in many instances data is available only up to 1962. The Agreement on Commerce between the two countries under study is presented as an Appendix.

Much of the material for this graduation exercise was gathered from the Department of Statistics and from the Trade Division of the Ministry of Commerce and Industry. Some data were also available from the Branch Office of JETRO in Kuala Lumpur.

I am especially indebted to my supervisor Dr. S.J. Gilani who not only supervised my work but also offered constructive criticism and helped considerably towards improving the contents of this graduation exercise. I am also grateful to the help given to me by Mr. Hajiwara, presently attached to the Department of Economics.
