(UNTOK PETANI2)

1. Bagi tahun 1964 kerajaan telah menetapkan harga padi \$16/- sa-pikul bagi padi yang ohukup kering dan berseh ia-itu kandungan wap basah-nya tidak lebih dari 13%.
2. Petani2 terutama sakali ahli2 Sharikat Kerjasama mesti-lah menjual padi mereka ka-Sharikat masing2.
3. Hanya Sharikat2 Kilang Padi Bekerjasama sahaja di-beri lesen membeli padi. Oleh yang demikian petani2 mesti-lah menjual padi mereka kepada pembeli2 yang berlesen ini dan tidak sakali2 kepada pembeli2 yang tidak berlesen ia-itu pembeli haram.
4. Padi hendak-lah di-nasokkan dalam guni yang tertentu yang boleh di-perolehi dari Sharikat sendiri. Padi itu hendak-lah ohukup kering dan berseh dari jerami2 atau pun benda2 lain dari padi. Potongan basah akan di-kenakan ka-atas padi yang tidak ohukup kering mengikut peratoran yang telah di-tetapkan.
5. Padi yang di-dapati terlalu basah atau pun kotor tidak akan di-terima oleh Sharikat.
6. Segala timbang menimbang di-lakukan di-Sharikat di-pastikan benar dan betul. Segala pembayaran di-buat pada hari itu juga.
7. Upah angkat mengangkut dan tambang lori dari Sharikat yang membeli padi ka-Persatuan Kilang Padi Tanjung Karang ada-lah di-tanggunggi oleh petani2 sendiri. Ini berma'ana bahawa petani akan mendapat bagi sa-pikul padi ia-lah harga sa-lepas di-tolak susut kandungan basah, berat guni, upah angkat mengangkut dan tambang dari Sharikat ka-Persatuan Kilang Padi Tanjung Karang dari harga \$16/- yang telah di-tetapkan oleh Keraja'an.
8. Jika sa-kira-nya Sharikat dapat keuntongan maka keuntongan itu akan di-peraitkan kembali kepada ahli2-nya yang ada menjual padi mereka kepada Sharikat.

9. Petani2 yang belum lagi menjadi ahli Sharikat Kilang Padi Berkerjasama2 di-seru masuk segera supaya dapat bersama2 menikmati segala faedah2 yang dapat di-beri oleh Sharikat.

Notification of Padi Marketing Programme  
for District of Kuala Selangor  
(For Farmers)

1. For the year 1964 the government has fixed the price of \$16/- per pikul for good, clean, dry padi i.e. padi having a moisture content of not exceeding 13%.
2. Farmers especially those who are members of a co-operative rice mill must sell their padi to the co-operative rice mill of which they are members.
3. Only co-operative rice mills are licensed to buy padi. As such farmers must sell their padi only to a licensed dealer and altogether forbidden to sell their padi to unlicensed or illegal dealers.
4. The padi must be packed into standard gunny sacks which can be obtained from the co-operative rice mill. The padi must be thoroughly dry and free from impurities. Deductions will be made from the weight of the padi which is not thoroughly dry according to the rates agreed upon.
5. Padi which is found to be excessively wet or dirty will not be accepted by the co-operative rice mill.
6. All weighings done in the co-operative rice mill is guaranteed to be true and correct. All payments will be made on the same day.
7. Handling and transport charges from the co-operative rice mill which buys the farmers' padi to the Union of Co-operative Rice Mill in Tanjong Karang will have to be paid by the farmers themselves. This means that the net price a farmer will get is the Guaranteed Minimum price of \$16/- less deductions for excess moisture content, handling and transport charges from the co-operative rice mill to the

**Union of Co-operative Rice Mill.**

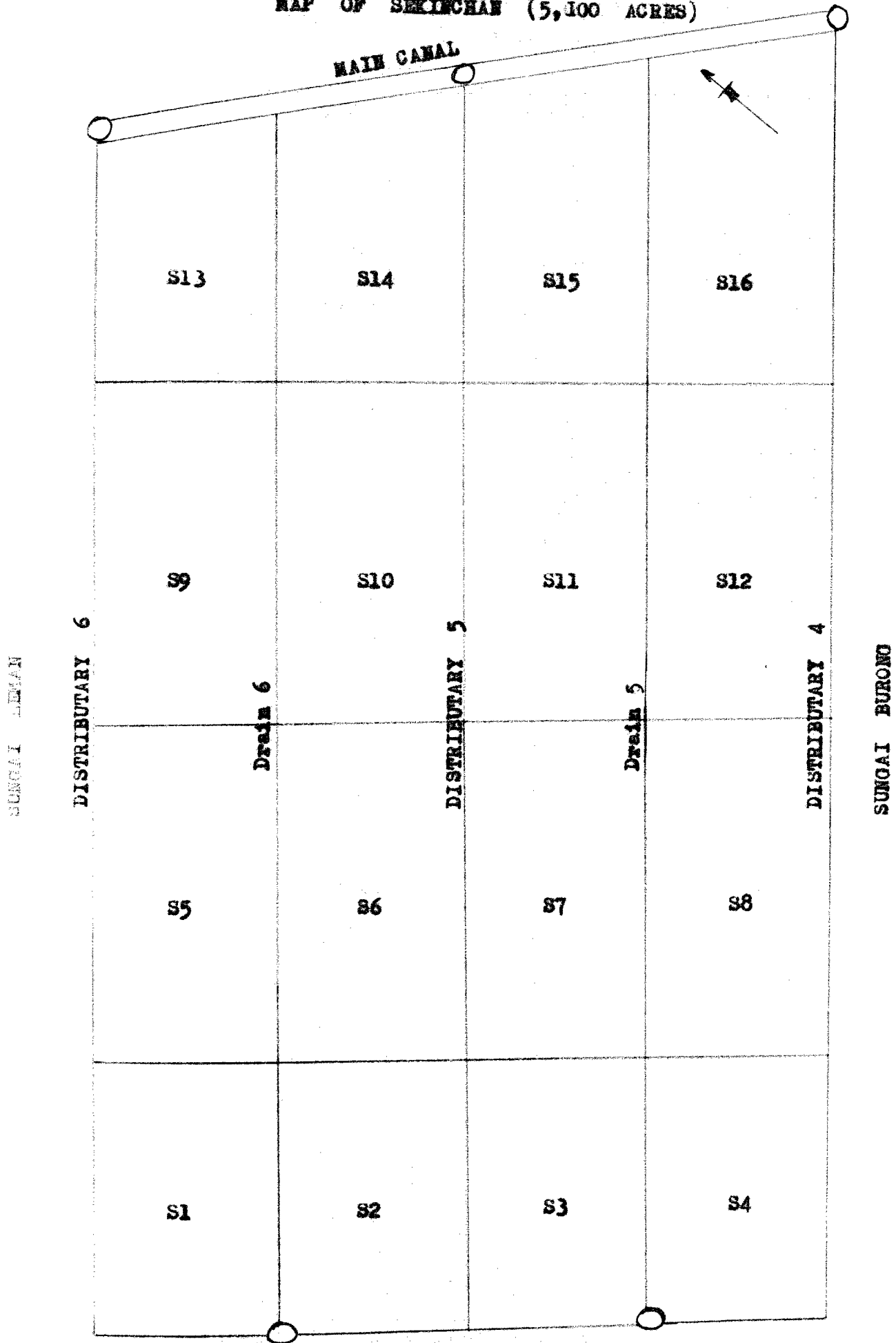
8. All profits made by the co-operative rice mill (if any) will be distributed to members according to their patronage of the society.

9. Those farmers who have not yet become members of a co-operative rice mill are called upon to join one immediately in order to benefit from all the advantages such co-operative society may offer.

MAP OF BLOCK S2

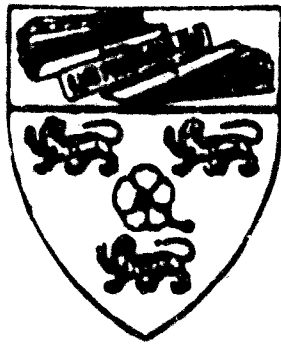
