

# CONSTITUTION FOR THE ISLAMIC ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION MALAYSIA

BY THIS DEED made the 13 day of October , 1976 corresponding to the  
19 day of ستمبر , 1396 the following are appointed Trustees of  
the Deed—

WHEREAS it is desirable for the promotion of charitable objects hereinafter stated  
that a trust be created;

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:

1. The Trust hereby created shall be known as the ISLAMIC ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION, MALAYSIA and is established in Malaysia for the propagation of the Religion of Islam and generally for the purpose of economic development; educational, social and welfare works amongst Muslims.

In furtherance of this object but not otherwise the Trustees shall have power—

- (a) to issue appeals for, or to collect or receive donations and bequests from time to time;
- (b) to support financially or otherwise Islamic Religion Councils in the States, Islamic associations, Islamic institutions and other Islamic bodies having similar objects as those of the Foundation and to co-ordinate and to advise on their activities in order to achieve maximum result;

(c) to publish for sale or free distribution leaflets, periodicals, books and other publications for the promotion of the objects of the Foundation;

(d) to hold and finance conferences, symposiums, seminars, lectures, meetings and discussions in furtherance of the objects of the Foundation;

(e) to issue periodical reports on the work of the Trustees.

2. The Trustees shall hold in trust all sums of money donated or bequeathed for the purpose of this Trust Deed and all investments at any time representing the same or any part thereof (all of which are hereinafter included in the expression "the Fund") and all income arising therefrom upon the trusts and subject to powers and provisions herein contained.

3. (a) The Trustees shall from time to time invest in their names any part of the capital or income of the Fund in or upon any investments for the time being authorised by the law for the investment of trust funds or in the purchase of land in Malaysia or place the same on deposit in the name of the Trustees at any licensed bank in Malaysia or with any licensed borrowing company being a wholly-owned subsidiary of a licensed bank and may sell or vary any of such investments and obtain payment of any monies so deposited as aforesaid.

(b) The income, capital and property of the Fund whencesoever derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Foundation as set forth in this Deed and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend bonus or otherwise howsoever by way of profit.

4. The Trustees shall stand possessed of the capital of the Fund and the investments from time to time representing the same upon trust to apply the same and the income thereof in perpetuity for the purpose of this Trust Deed.

5. The Trustees shall out of the Fund pay all costs and expenses of or incidental to the management of the Management of the Fund (including payment of reasonable allowances to the Trustees) or the execution of any of the Trusts or powers of this Deed.

6. The Trustees may with the prior written approval of the Prime Minister, Malaysia borrow monies either by way of charge of all or any part of the trust property or otherwise, for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the foundation.

7. (a) The trustees of this Deed shall consist when complete of not less than five but not more than nine trustees. If and whenever the number of trustees shall be less than five then one or more new trustees shall forthwith be appointed in the manner hereinafter provided so as to bring the number of trustees up to five.

(b) The first trustees are the persons hereinbefore named as Trustees.

(c) The power of appointing a trustee or removing a trustee shall be vested in the Prime Minister, Malaysia.

There shall be a President and Deputy President of the Foundation and the following provisions shall apply in respect of their appointments and functions:

- (a) Dato' Sri Haji Kamaruddin bin Haji Mohd. Isa shall be the first President. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Trustees and shall be responsible for the implementation of the decision of the Trustees and may perform any other functions in relation to the Foundation in accordance with any directions which may be given from time to time by the Prime Minister, Malaysia.
- (b) Datuk Dr Arshad bin Ayub shall be the first Deputy President. The Deputy President shall in the absence of the President, preside at all meetings of the Trustees and carry out for and on behalf of the President all his functions under the Deed.
- (c) All future appointments of Presidents and Deputy Presidents shall be made from time to time by the Prime Minister, Malaysia.

Every Trustee whether on a first or in a subsequent appointment to office shall before acting in the trust of this Deed sign in the minute book for which provision is hereinafter made a declaration of acceptance and of willingness to act for the purposes of the Deed.

10. The following regulations shall govern the procedure of the trustees—

- (a) The Trustees shall hold meetings at least twice in every calendar year and at such other times and in such places as the President shall from time to time decide. A Special meeting may be summoned at any time by the President or any two of the Trustees upon seven days' notice being given to all the other Trustees of the matters to be discussed.
- (b) All meetings shall be presided by the President or in his absence, the Deputy President or in the absence of both, the Trustee chosen by the Trustees present.
- (c) There shall be a quorum when three Trustees are present at any meeting.
- (d) Every matter shall be determined by a majority of votes of the Trustees present and voting on the question.
- (e) Any resolution of the Trustees may be rescinded or varied from time to time by the Trustees.
- (f) The Trustees shall provide and keep a minute book in which shall be entered the proceedings of the Trustees.
- (g) The Foundation may invite any person who is not a member to attend any meeting of the Foundation to give information or advice but he shall not be entitled to vote.

- (f) The Trustees shall provide books of account in which shall be kept all proper accounts of all monies received and paid respectively by or on behalf of the Trustees for the purposes of this Deed.
  - (g) Every contract agreed upon shall be sealed and two Trustees, one of them either the President or Deputy President, shall attest the fixing of the seal.
  - (h) The appropriation of monies shall be made by the Trustees at their meetings.
- (i) All accounts of the Foundation shall be signed by any two of their members, one of whom shall be The President or the Deputy President.
- (j) The Trustees shall arrange for all the accounts of the Foundation to be audited yearly by the Auditor General or any auditor approved by him and prepare an annual report and an annual budget to be submitted to the Prime Minister, Malaysia.

11. The Trustees may from time to time open and maintain in their names a bank account or bank accounts at such bank or banks as they shall from time to time decide and may at any time pay any monies forming part of the Fund to the credit of any such account or accounts or place the same on deposit with any bank or banks and all cheques and orders for the payment of money shall be signed by the President or Deputy President and one other of the Trustees.

12. The Trustees may from time to time amend the provisions of this Trust Deed or wholly or partially revoke or alter all or any of the purposes to which the Fund may be applied and may declare that in lieu thereof the Fund or any part thereof shall be applicable, and the same shall thereunder become applicable, for such other purpose or purposes as the Trustees shall think proper.



# YAPEIM lancar 'Projek Al-Qardhul Hasan'

BANGI 24 Nov. — Yayasan Pembangunan Ekonomi Islam Malaysia (YAPEIM) hari ini melancarkan skim pinjaman menurut Islam yang dikenali sebagai 'Projek Al-Qardhul Hasan' bagi membantu golongan miskin melaksanakan rancangan - rancangan ekonomi yang berdaya maju.

Pengurusan skim itu yang julu kalinya dilaksanakan di negara ini akan dikendalikan oleh Bank Islam Malaysia Berhad (BIMB).

Bagi pelancaran skim itu, YAPEIM menyediakan \$250,000 sebagai permulaan untuk dibahagi - bahagikan kepada golongan yang memerlukan.

Pengarah YAPEIM, Haji Ismail Basri menyampaikan cek tersebut kepada Pengurus BIMB, Raja Tan Sri Mohar Raja Badiozaman di satu majlis yang diadakan di Institut Latihan Pengurusan Petronas di sini petang ini, sempena persidangan pengarah - pengarah BIMB.

Menurut, Haji Ismail, semua 25 cawangan BIMB di seluruh negara

akan memperolehi \$10,000 tiap - tiap cawangan bagi mengendalikan skim pinjaman di bawah projek Al-Qardhul Hasan YAPEIM.

Katanya, para peminjam yang layak menyertai skim ini adalah golongan miskin yang berpendapatan kurang daripada \$50 seorang sebulan atau kurang \$250 sebulan sekeluarga.

Peminjam mestilah mempunyai projek ekonomi yang berpotensi di berbagai bidang termasuk perniagaan, pertanian atau lain - lain yang boleh mendatangkan hasil bagi menambah pendapatan.

Menurutnya, jumlah pinjaman yang dikeluarkan tidak melebihi \$1,000 untuk satu - satu projek dan bayaran balik boleh dibuat secara mingguan, bulanan, suku tahun, setengah tahun, setahun sekali atau sekaligus dalam tempoh tidak melebihi dua tahun.

Beliau memberitahu, peruntukan \$250,000 yang dikeluarkan oleh YAPEIM hari ini merupakan geran permulaan bagi skim pinjaman tersebut.

YAYASAN Pembangunan Ekonomi Islam Malaysia (Yapeim) akan mengeluarkan bantuan buku teks kepada kira-kira 10 pustaka sekolah menengah agama rakyat bernilai \$100,000 sebelum akhir tahun ini.

Proses memilih sekolah yang layak menerimanya meliputi seluruh negara sedang dibuat dan bantuan itu akan dilaksanakan sebaik saja sekolah-sekolah itu dikenal pasti.

Bantuan itu diberikan khusus kepada sekolah berkenaan kera na kedudukan sekolah agama rakyat kebanyakannya masih banyak yang belum mampu menyediakan kemudahan perpustakaan dengan sempurna, kata pengarahnya, Haji Ismail Basri.

Di samping bantuan itu, Yapeim dengan kerjasama Kementerian Pendidikan setakat ini menyumbangkan lebih 300 pita kaset al-Quran kepada sekolah-sekolah menengah agama. Pita kaset yang diterbitkan itu adalah mengenai fakta sains seperti yang terkandung dalam al-Quran.

Bantuan ini bertujuan supaya pelajar sedar bahawa mempelajari sains adalah selaras dengan tuntutan Islam dan menjadikan mereka lebih dekat dengan Allah.

Selain itu Yapeim juga memperuntukkan lebih \$350,000 untuk kegiatan menterjemah kitab-kitab tulisan ulama ke Bahasa Melayu.

Katanya, kegiatan menterjemah bermula sejak dua tahun lalu. Ia adalah kegiatan usahasama Yapeim, Dewan Bahasa dan Pustaka dengan satu panel penterjemah terdiri daripada pakar-pakar bahasa dan ilmu syariah Universiti Islam Antarbangsa (UIA).

"Penerbitan kitab-kitab iri menjadi usaha amal jariah yang besar oleh penyumbang berkenaan kepada Yapeim," katanya.

Menurut Haji Ismail, bidang pendidikan sentiasa mendapat perhatian utama dalam kegiatan bantuan amal jariah Yapeim. Sehingga Julai tahun ini Yapeim telah membelanjakan \$1,600,000 daripada \$4,930,000 bantuan amal jariah yang dieluarkan.

Tiga bidang lain yang turut disertai oleh Yapeim ialah bantuan kemudahan peribadatan (\$1.25 juta), bantuan kebajikan awam (\$738,500) dan bantuan untuk meningkatkan ekonomi keluarga fakir miskin (\$1.35 juta).

Haji Ismail berkata, sebagai yayasan yang bergerak di peringkat kebangsaan, Yapeim sentiasa berusaha supaya bantuan yang diberi dapat dimanfaatkan oleh ramai orang.

"Sebab itulah bantuan yang diberikan itu seboleh-bolehnya kemudahan yang berbentuk jamaah, bukan individu," katanya.

Bantuan pendidikan Yapeim termasuklah kepada taman asuhan Islam dan sekolah agama rakyat. Setakat ini Yapeim telah menyumbangkan bantuan berjumlah lebih \$200,000 kepada lebih 200 taman asuhan Islam di seluruh negara.

Sejak empat tahun lalu sehingga kini \$440,000 dibelanjakan untuk tujuan ini. Sementara itu Yapeim telah memulakan kegiatan bantuan perpustakaan kepada sekolah kebangsaan luar bandar sejak dua tahun lalu dengan jumlah bantuan \$320,000.





# 170,000 dikenal pasti miskin

KUALA LUMPUR, Ahad — Kira-kira 170,000 isi rumah di seluruh negara, dikenal pasti berpendapatan di bawah \$175 dan layak diper-timbangkan untuk menyertai Program Bantuan Rakyat Ter-miskin.

Perangkaan itu membabitkan 25,000 isi rumah termiskin di Ke-dah, Perak (22,000), Terengganu (20,000), Kelantan (16,960), Johor (10,000), Pulau Pinang (8,000), Se-langor (8,000), Melaka (3,800), Per-lis (3,100), Wilayah Persekutuan (215), Sabah (22,000) dan Sarawak (25,000).

Timbalan Ketua Pengarah Unit Penyelarasan Pelaksanaan di Ja-batan Perdana Menteri (JPM), Dr Abdul Aziz Muhamad, berkata pe-rangkaan itu diperolehi hasil ka-jian yang dibuat secara rambang oleh Unit Perancang Ekonomi di JPM.


Bagaimanapun, katanya, satu daftar lengkap mengenai keluarga termiskin di semua negeri akan di-

siapkan oleh Pejabat Daerah un-tuk diserahkan kepada Jawatan-kuasa Penyelaras Pelaksanaan Program Peringkat Kebangsaan, awal tahun depan.

"Ini untuk mengelakkan ada pi-hak yang mengambil kesempatan mengaku mereka miskin se-dangkan ada rakyat lain yang le-bih layak dibantu. Tetapi dengan adanya daftar nama itu, mereka yang benar-benar daif saja akan dipilih," katanya kepada *Berita Harian*.

Schubungan itu, beliau meminta pegawai daerah bergerak sebagai satu pasukan bagi mengenal pasti dan merancang projek sesuai un-tuk keluarga terbabit mengikut keadaan ekonomi di situ.


