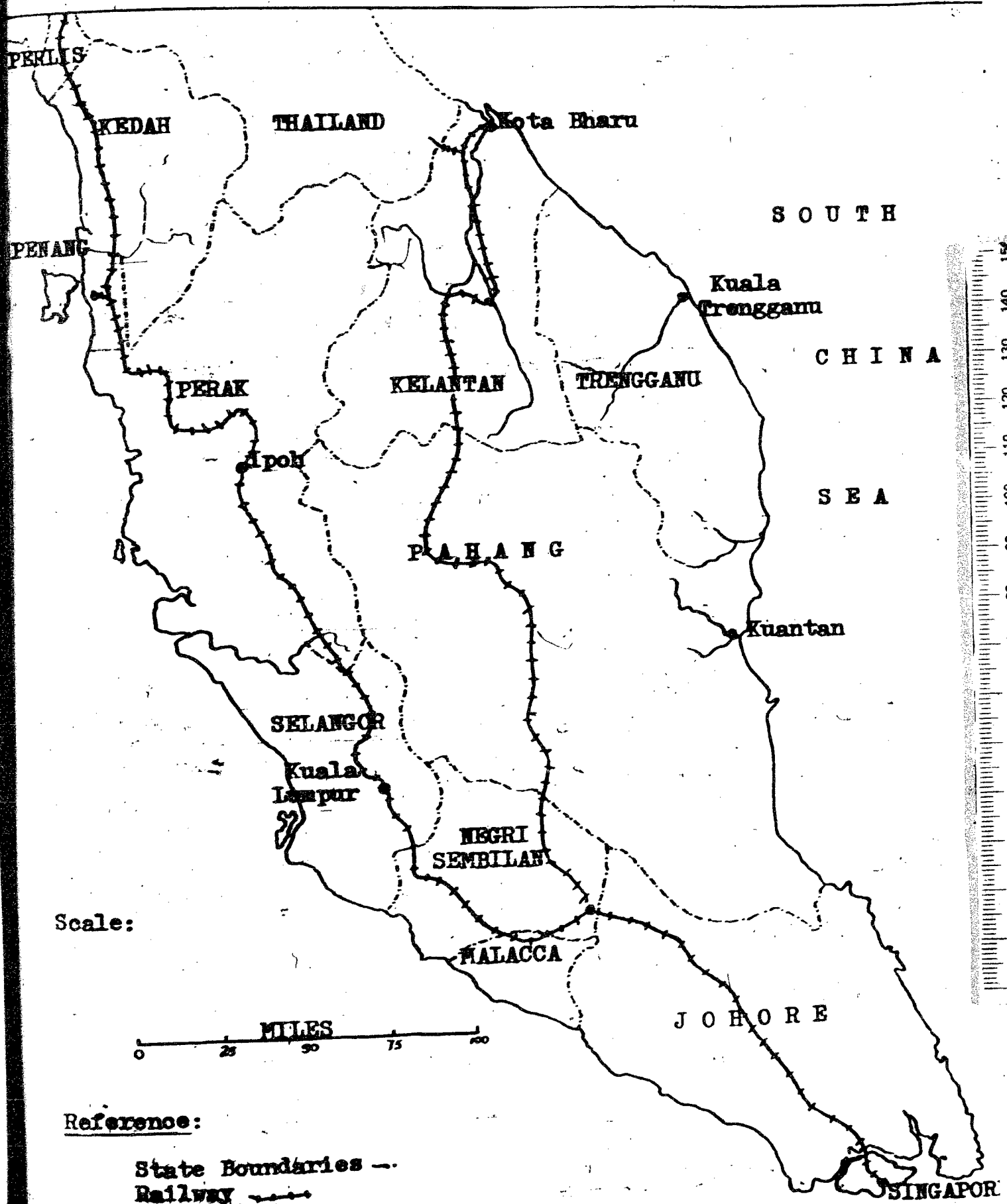

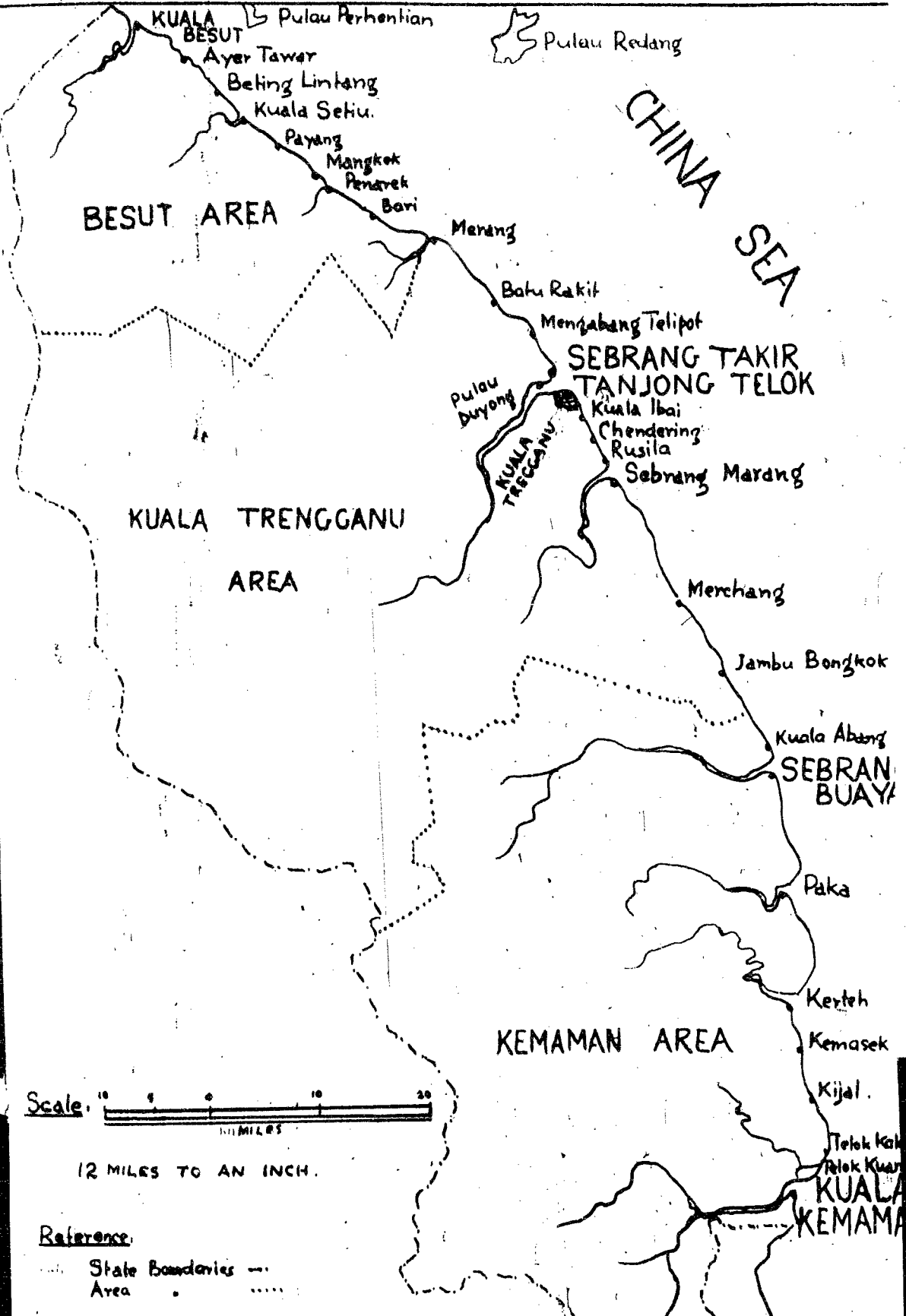

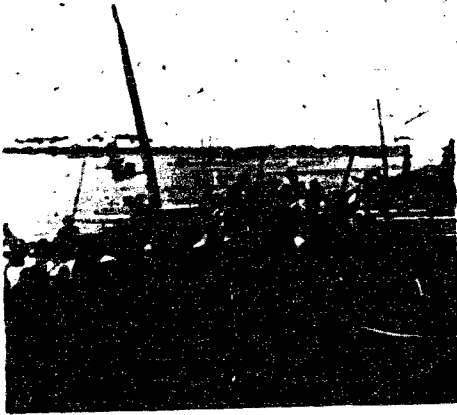

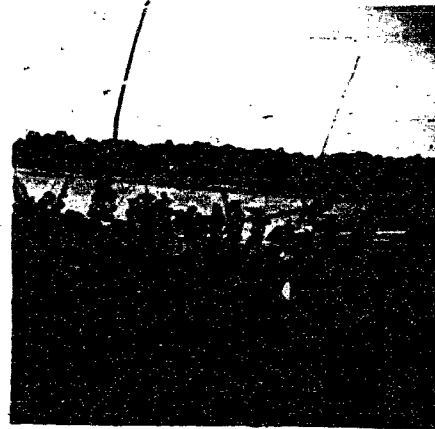

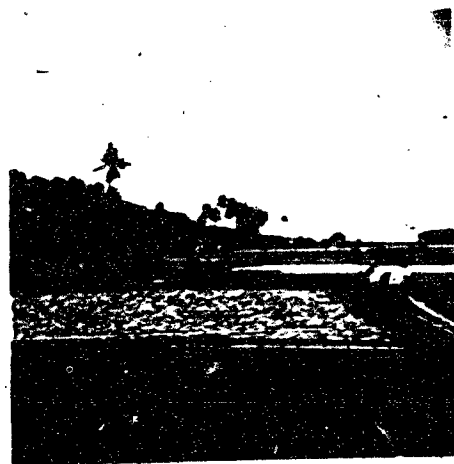

The net is mended in the afternoon.

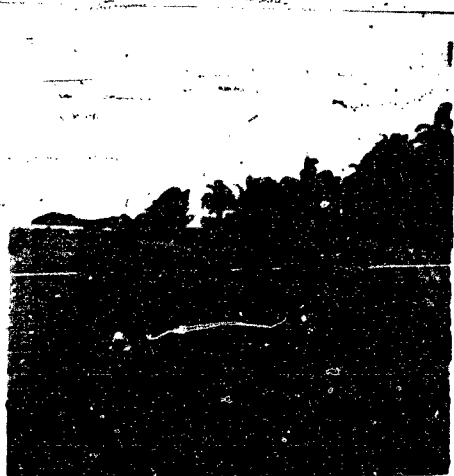
PLATE IV

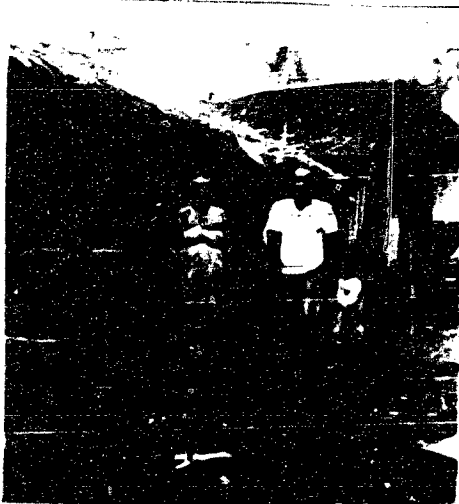

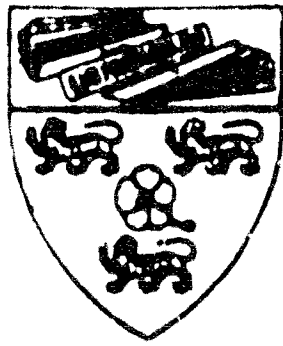
